Requirements: All first and second year graduate students with BMED as the home school must register for BMED 7001 Seminar in both the fall and spring terms (a total of four terms with Satisfactory grades).

Research Seminars:

In-person attendance at five research seminars is required. Acceptable seminars are offered by Georgia Tech, Emory, and Georgia State and include speakers, workshops, and doctoral defenses. One full BME Graduate Student Seminar Series event may count toward this fulfillment per semester. Doctoral proposals, other talks not led by a speaker with a PhD, and seminars that are not research-oriented do not qualify.

Professional/Career Development Events:

In-person attendance at two professional/career development events is required. BME will provide at least two in-house events each semester that will qualify. Other events at Georgia Tech and Emory University in the arena of professional and career development, including seminars, workshops, career panels, etc., also qualify.

Documentation: This completed TYPED form must be signed by the student, then submitted via the T-Square course site by the last day of classes of the term as per the GT Registrar's calendar. A student who is not officially registered for the course may not submit a participation form and will not receive future credit for any attendance in that term. For registered students, failure to submit the completed form by the deadline will result in a grade of U (unsatisfactory).
